EARLY VOTING BALLOT BY MAIL

To request an Application for Ballot by Mail, eligible voters can send an Application for Ballot by Mail form or an "informal application" by mail (Dallas County Elections Dept., 1520 Round Table Drive, Dallas, TX 75247), fax to 214.819.6301, or email to EVAPPLICATIONS@DALLASCOUNTY.ORG no later than **Friday, February 21, 2020**. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** If you fax or email your application form, please be aware that you must also mail the form to the Dallas County Elections Department, Attn: Early Voting, 1520 Round Table Drive, Dallas, TX 75247 within four (4) business days. Application for Ballot by Mail, related instructions and eligibility requirements are on our website at www.dallascountyvotes.org/absentee-voting.

Texas Election Code §84 now provides that a voter may deliver their carrier envelope containing their marked ballot in person on election day from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. to the early voting clerk at Dallas County Elections. The voter must provide an acceptable form of ID upon delivery of the carrier envelope. Texas is an open-primary state. Voters decide every two years whether they will help pick the Democratic or the Republican Parties nominees to run in the **November 3, 2020** General Election. Whatever primary a voter decides to vote in, she/he can only vote in that same party's runoff election, if a runoff is held. You can also vote for either party's candidate in the general election. Consequently, pursuant to **new legislation**, Texas Election Code §172.126(g-1), all voters must choose which primary election, Democratic or Republican, they wish to vote. A voter may verbally tell the attending poll worker which ballot they would

like, or they may indicate by pointing to the sign (located at the qualifying table) that corresponds to the party primary they want to vote.

Early Voting In-Person begins Tuesday, February 17, 2020

Any qualified voter for the March 3, 2020 Primary Elections may vote in person at any of the forty-five (45) early voting locations on the dates and times indicated below.

A Voter who becomes sick or disabled on or after **Thursday, February 20, 2020** may vote a late ballot if the sickness or disability prevents the voter from appearing at the polling place without the likelihood of needing personal assistance or of injuring his or her health. An application to vote late due to sickness or disability may be submitted through 5:00 PM on Primary Election Day (Texas Election Code §§102.001 & 102.003).

A voter who will be absent from his county of residence due to a death of an immediate family member occurring on or after **Thursday, February 27, 2020** may apply for a late ballot. Application may be made after the last day of early voting in person, up to the close of business on the day before primary election day. (Secs. 103.001 & 103.003).
