What is the Student Worker Program?



Dallas County Elections Department Student Pollworker Program was initiated in 2011 with small amount of local High Schools as participants. Now we have over 30 High Schools throughout Dallas County participating in the program.

The program allows the students the exciting opportunity to serve as poll workers on Election Day as they learn and take part in the electoral process. Giving them first hand knowledge of what happens on Election Day. Preparing them to be engaged and knowledgeable voting citizens.

Responsibilities Include:

- * Setting up / opening polling place
- * Assisting the Election Judge through out the day.
- * Assisting voters
- * Closing the polling place

Is Training Provided?

Training is provided, student will be given hands-on training on Election Day Equipment. You will also be trained on what rules, laws and regulations to follow. To accommodate your school schedule we hold training after school and on the week-end our main office building.

Who Can Apply?

- * 16 years of age or older
- * Enrolled in an accredited High School with in Dallas County.
- * Must have Principal and Parental consent to be out of school .
- * Must be a United States Citizen.

If you speak and communicate fluently in the Spanish Language we can definitely use your assistance. Currently we are only required to accommodate the English and Spanish language but our community continues to grow. If you speak any other lan-
